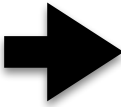

About the Funds

Annual Dues: \$30.00. This is the basic Association membership. Your annual dues cover administrative costs of the Association such as taxes, mailings, Clubhouse repairs, mowing and maintenance. We also publish and distribute the annual Lake Directory to our members.

Fireworks Fund (suggested \$25 per member). The annual Fireworks Display on Labor Day weekend is probably the most anticipated and popular event of the summer. It is also the most expensive. Fundraising comes from member donations plus an active pop can return program. In 2022, the fireworks cost \$1,000 per minute.

Safety & Law Enforcement Fund/Marine Watch Officer (suggested \$10 per member). We promote safety on and off the water. Holiday weekends can be crowded and more subject to incidents. We hire a Sheriff Dept. Marine Safety Officer to monitor activity on the water and prevent problems on as many weekends as fund donations allow. We also have a volunteer Marine Watch Patrol to monitor boating activity.

Flower Fund (suggested \$10 per member), When a member is recovering from surgery or injury, the Association sends flowers and/or a card if the Association is notified. In the event of the death of a member, a separate program covers a memorial donation in keeping with the family's wishes.

Recreation Fund (suggested \$30 per member). Covers the cost of summer concerts at the Clubhouse and prize money for the Road Parade (among other activities).

Fish Stocking Fund (suggested \$20 per member). The fish stocking fund is primarily used to purchase larger size fish for stocking the lake every other year. The DNR stocks the lake with walleye fingerlings (4-7 in) in alternate years at no cost to the Association. This fund also covers prizes associated with the Fish Contest, which is a popular summer event.

Clubhouse Renovation Fund. (suggested \$25 per member). It's been several years since the Clubhouse has received any significant attention to the interior; it could really use some sprucing up to make it more functional and attractive for the activities it serves. The Board and Clubhouse Committee have been discussing updated bathrooms, new flooring, new ceiling and better lighting. The General Fund can't cover the cost of everything without supplemental donations from our membership.
